1	The earth is the Lord's, and all it contains, The world, and those who dwell in it.	Proclaim truth about God and the creation
2	For He has founded it upon the seas And established it upon the rivers.	The Holy Spirit hovered over the deep, and is the river that flows from within. Invite Him to lead
3	Who may ascend into the hill of the Lord? And who may stand in His holy place?	Ascend in worship. Lift hearts and voices
4	He who has clean hands and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to falsehood And has not sworn deceitfully.	Who may stand? Short time waiting on the Holy Spirit to clear any blockage. Use 1 John 1:9
5	He shall receive a blessing from the Lord And righteousness from the God of his salvation.	Receive blessing. Cleansing from all unrighteousness. Proclaim this
6	This is the generation of those who seek Him, Who seek Your face—even Jacob. <i>Selah</i> .	Intentional seeking Him now, in yieldedness. Maybe use a song
7	Lift up your heads, O gates, And be lifted up, O ancient doors, That the King of glory may come in!	Look to Jesus. Share insights. Draw conclusions for prayer
8	Who is the King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, The Lord mighty in battle.	Prayer as He leads. New Creation prayer. Proclaim/enforce in Spirit. Yielded to Him, flow as one, open to a "solo" part in areas He revealed
9	Lift up your heads, O gates, And lift <i>them</i> up, O ancient doors, That the King of glory may come in!	If time, seek Jesus again for next round of prayer (next "music piece")
10	Who is this King of glory? The Lord of hosts, He is the King of glory.	Close with honoring the King
