- I am a saint (Eph 1:18)
- I am forgiven of all sin and have redemption through Jesus blood; Christ brought us righteousness and sanctification (1 John 2:12, Col 1:22, Eph 1:7, 1 Cor 1:30)
- I have been justified (Rom 5:1)
- I am a holy partaker of a heavenly calling (Heb 3:1)
- I am raised up with Christ and seated with Him in heavenly places (Eph 2:6, Rom 6:4)
- My citizenship is in heaven (Phil 3:20)
- I am qualified to share in the inheritance of the saints (Col 1:12)
- I have eternal life (John 6:47)
- I am the righteousness of God in Jesus Christ (2 Cor 5:21, Rom 5:17)
- I am a joint-heir with Christ; and suffer and am glorified with Him (Rom 8:17, Eph 3:6)
